<p>1500 – 1600 Hrs</p>	<p>Session 2: Perspectives on Energy Transition & Decarbonization Pathways in the Metals Industry</p> <p>Most of the Indian steel producers have already adopted their respective targets for Decarbonization in line with Net Zero targets of India. With the recent definition of Green Steel taxonomy by the Govt. of India, the adoption of green steel production technologies is likely to gather further traction. The Energy Transition & Decarbonization pathways will help the industry to be in line with worldwide environmental objectives in tandem with sustainability. This transition not only invites new technologies and innovation in the sector but also prepares Indian manufacturers to take advantage of international trade policies that are likely to be increasingly biased towards low embedded carbon products. However, the successful migration to lower embedded carbon pathways will additionally require the establishment of conducive regulatory support and policies / incentives, the enhancement of supporting infrastructure on energy transition, and the upskilling of the workforce to facilitate a seamless transition.</p>
